



OVESTRUCK *Friends* beauty Courteney Cox has been told she should wed her boyfriend, David Arquette – by a psychic guru she now counts as a close real-life friend.

Courteney, 34, has turned to Beverly Hills clairvoyant Shooshan George for advice over her romance with handsome David, 25. The couple fell head-over-heels in love when they co-starred in the movies *Scream* and *Scream 2*.

And Shooshan, who lists Cher and La Toya Jackson among her Hollywood clients, confirms, "I've told Courteney that David is good for her. It's not a case of me giving my blessing to their union. But I am positive they are suited to each other. Now it's up to them to decide what they want to do."

Courteney consults Shooshan over virtually every aspect of her life and regularly visits the psychic's Beverly Hills office and home in Encino, a leafy Los Angeles suburb.

Shooshan has told her has come to pass. When Courteney's career was in a downward spiral, the psychic told her she would find overnight success. Within weeks, her TV sitcom *Friends* took off around the world.

Will Courteney now pop the question to David after being told by Shooshan they are made for each other?

The fortune-teller to the famous tells *Woman's Day*, "I can't say how it's going to happen. But I do know they will be together for a long time.

"Courteney and I are close, so I can't say too much. But it would be true to say that she asked me about David because she was worried about where their relationship was going. Like all women, she wants to know what's in store.

"So I told her, I'm not going to pass on exactly what I said, but I did reassure her and help put any doubts she may have had to the back of her mind - just where they belong.

"There is no question about it, Courteney and David are completely compatible. Courteney was so happy she hugged and kissed me when I told her she had a completely contented romantic future with David."

The Iranian-born guru, who so impressed Michael Jackson's sister La Toya she helped

her set up her own psychic hotline in Hollywood, adds, "I have been blessed with a gift. Exactly how or why I don't know.

"But I do know that I have helped put people's minds at rest and guided them towards achieving what they want out of life.

"People come to me for so many reasons. Sometimes, when there is sadness, grief or anxiety, I am able to explain why these emotions need not be felt, why it is possible to still touch the past as well as look into the future.

"I advised Courteney three years ago that her relationship with Michael Keaton would not work. And it didn't."

Shooshan adds, "Courteney trusts me implicitly and I mustn't say any more in case that trust is damaged. But, yes, our friendship has grown.

"I'm happy some of the things I've told her have come to pass and have brought her joy.

"I'm positive she and David have a very firm and secure future together. I certainly believe very strongly that they should marry."

Another of 52-year-old Shooshan's regular visitors to her anonymous-looking LA office has been singer Cher, devastated earlier this year following the death of

ex-husband Sonny Bono in a skiing accident.

The singer, who has also consulted another leading psychic, James Van Praagh, has since said she has been "in touch" with Sonny.

"Cher was filled with guilt about how they didn't speak, possibly even hated each other, for years after the divorce until eventually they became friends again," says Shooshan.

"She has consulted a number of psychics and the one thing we all concur on is that she should not feel that way. I believe she is now reconciled to the truth that Sonny is still there for her spiritually and, for want of a better phrase, there are no hard feelings.

"There have been other celebrities I have helped, but virtually all choose not to bring their consultations into the public domain and I have to respect that.

"Most come to me as a result of word of mouth. If people find they can trust me and I can be of help guiding them through life, then they recommend me to their friends."

And occasionally, she and her clients even become friends. "It's not often that I become personally close to my clients, although that is true in the case of Courteney," says Shooshan.

"I don't actually instruct her or anything like that. I simply try to point out to her - and to everyone I deal with - the best possible path forward.

"Some people may scoff at psychic help, but those who are open-minded enough to believe find that my guidance really does enhance their lives."
